
#### **DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES**

As you would be aware from previous communication we are attempting to improve our morning drop-off and afternoon dismissal procedures at St John's. Changes to our morning drop-off procedures (parish carpark entrance) were communicated to our parents / carers last Thursday via Skoolbag and a parent / carer letter which was sent home. Please be advised that the changes come into effect on Monday 24th May. I ask that all parents / carers become familiar with the new procedures and comply with the changes. The current A - K and L - Z distribution of family groups for dismissal in the afternoon will remain the same for now. However, for ease of dismissal children will sit in their stage group to be dismissed by the teachers on duty. Two portable loud speakers have been purchased for use by teachers for afternoon dismissal via the top gate (parish carpark.)

These changes are necessary for the safety of our students and staff.

#### **FRIDAY ASSEMBLY**

Last Friday we welcomed Early Stage One parents / carers to assembly. During our assembly our kindergarten children shared a prayer and with the support of their Year Six buddies read parts of the story 'Room on the Broom'. This was the children's first presentation at assembly and we were very proud of them. In Week 6 we will welcome Stage One parents / carers to our assembly. ### SCHOOL DROP OFF AND PICK UP

### The following changes will come into effect on Monday 24th May 2021

There are two options to enter the school in the morning for all students A to Z.

- 1) Via Kiss and Drop- refer to procedure below
- **2) Front gate (Gate 1)** for students walking to school or being dropped off by their parents not using the kiss and drop zone. These parents / carers must park their vehicle in McCulloch Street or nearby roads and walk the child to the front gate McCulloch Street (gate 1). Parents / carers are no longer permitted to park in the parish carpark to walk their child/ren over to the school entrance.

#### **Kiss and Drop procedure**

- Parents / carers must remain in their car when dropping children off using the designated drop-off lane in the parish carpark. This lane will be created using bollards.
- Children sitting in the back seat when being dropped off must alight from the driver side rear door.
- Parents / carers must remain in their vehicle.
- Parents / carers must always drive with caution when on site.
- Parents / carers using kiss and drop must enter the site via the McCulloch Street entrance and exit the site via the Garfield Road exit.
- Children's school bags should be in the car for easy access. Students are not permitted to go to the boot of a vehicle to remove a school bag.
- Parents/carers and children must not enter the school site on foot at the McCulloch Street driveway or the Garfield Road entrance and walk through the parish carpark to the top gate. **This practice is unsafe.**

At this stage there isn't any changes to afternoon dismissal; it remains the same, A-K Parish Carpark (Gate 3), L-Z Front Gate McCulloch Street (Gate 1). However, parents / carers are reminded to use the family name sign that was distributed last term. If you have misplaced your name sign, please contact the school office for a new one.

Any students that arrive late will need to be dropped off at the pedestrian gate on McCulloch Street (Gate 1) and be signed in by their parent/carer (A partial absence will be recorded)

STRICTLY NO ACCESS THROUGH THE TOP GATE (PARISH CAR PARK) BETWEEN 8.50am and 2.50pm
